# Order of Worship

October 14, 2018

Preparing our Hearts: If you arrive a little early, prepare your heart for worship by reading and thinking about this text:

- *For thus says the One who is high and lifted up, who inhabits eternity, whose name is Holy: "I dwell in the high and holy place, and also with him who is of a contrite and lowly spirit, to revive the spirit of the lowly, and to revive the heart of the contrite.*  
(Isa. 57:15 ESV)

## Call to Worship:

- God calls us to worship
  - *Those who trust in the LORD are like Mount Zion, which cannot be moved, but abides forever. As the mountains surround Jerusalem, so the LORD surrounds his people, from this time forth and forevermore.* (Ps. 125:1-2 ESV)
- We humbly respond with praise
  - "Holy Is The Lord"
  - "Take My Life (Holiness)"

## Gospel Assurance:

- Our need for Jesus
  - "Have Mercy On Me"
- God's grace
  - *For if the blood of goats and bulls, and the sprinkling of defiled persons with the ashes of a heifer, sanctify for the purification of the flesh, how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without blemish to God, purify our conscience from dead works to serve the living God.* (Heb. 9:13-14 ESV)
  - "Come Praise And Glorify"

What we Believe: As a church we want to affirm our unity in what we believe.

- *We believe that we are justified freely or by grace through redemption in Jesus Christ. And therefore we cling to this foundation, which is firm forever, giving all glory to God, humbling ourselves, and recognizing ourselves as we are; not claiming a thing for ourselves or our merits and leaning and resting on the sole*

*obedience of Christ crucified, which is our when we believe in him.  
Amen. (Based on Belgic Confession, Article 23)*

Church Life/Greeting: In Christ, we live and fellowship together as believers. We take time to learn what is going on in our church, and to greet one another as we worship.

Prayer for Understanding: We pray that God will open our hearts and minds to the preaching of His Word.

Lord's Supper: In taking communion together, we remember the death of Christ as we proclaim it to one another as we consume the elements.

- "Lead Me To The Cross"

Praise to God (Doxology): We end our time of worship together as we resound in praises together.

- "Indescribable"

God Blesses: We go into the world this week with God's blessings as He enables us to serve Him.

- *Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. (2 Cor. 1:2 ESV)*
