Preparing Our Hearts: If you arrive a little early, prepare your heart for worship by reading and thinking about this text:

- *Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places.* (Ephesians 1:3 ESV)

Call to Worship:

- God calls us to worship
 - *Hear, O LORD, when I cry aloud; be gracious to me and answer me! You have said, “Seek my face.” My heart says to you, “Your face, LORD, do I seek.* (Psalm 27:7–8 ESV)
- We humbly respond with praise
 - “All Creatures Of Our God And King”
 - “You Oh Lord Are A Great God”

Gospel Assurance:

- Our need for Jesus
 - *And when the LORD your God brings you into the land that he swore to your fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give you—with great and good cities that you did not build, and houses full of all good things that you did not fill, and cisterns that you did not dig, and vineyards and olive trees that you did not plant—and when you eat and are full, then take care lest you forget the LORD, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery.* (Deuteronomy 6:10–12 ESV)
 - Prayer of confession
- God’s grace
 - *Remember Jesus Christ, risen from the dead, the offspring of David, as preached in my gospel, for which I am suffering, bound with chains as a criminal. But the word of God is not bound!* (2 Timothy 2:8–9 ESV)
 - “Nothing But The Blood”
 - “Heavenly Father, Beautiful Son”

What We Believe: As a church we want to affirm our unity in what we believe.

- *We believe in one God, Creator of all things, holy, infinitely perfect, and eternally existing in a loving unity of three equally divine Persons: the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. Having limitless knowledge and sovereign power, God has graciously purposed from eternity to redeem a people for Himself and to make all things new for His own glory. Amen. (EFCA Statement Of Faith)*

Prayer: We bring our requests to the Lord through Jesus Christ.

Church Life/Greeting: In Christ, we live and fellowship together as believers. We take time to learn what is going on in our church, and to greet one another as we worship.

Prayer for Understanding: We pray that God will open our hearts and minds to the preaching of His Word.

Sermon:

- 2 Corinthians 11:16-33

Lord's Supper: In taking communion together, we remember the death of Christ as we proclaim it to one another as we consume the elements.

- “Hallelujah What A Savior”

Praise to God (Doxology): We end our time of worship together as we resound in praises together.

- “All My Ways Are Known To You”

God Blesses: We go into the world this week with God's blessings as He enables us to serve Him.

- *And after you have suffered a little while, the God of all grace, who has called you to his eternal glory in Christ, will himself restore, confirm, strengthen, and establish you. To him be the dominion forever and ever. Amen. (1 Peter 5:10–11 ESV)*
