# Order of Worship

Preparing Our Hearts: If you arrive a little early, prepare your heart for worship by reading and thinking about this text:

- *For as in one body we have many members, and the members do not all have the same function, so we, though many, are one body in Christ, and individually members one of another.*  
(Romans 12:4–5 ESV)

## Call to Worship:

- God calls us to worship
  - *May God be gracious to us and bless us and make his face to shine upon us, that your way may be known on earth, your saving power among all nations. Let the peoples praise you, O God; let all the peoples praise you! Let the nations be glad and sing for joy, for you judge the peoples with equity and guide the nations upon earth. Let the peoples praise you, O God; let all the peoples praise you!* (Psalm 67:1–5 ESV)
- We humbly respond with praise
  - “All Creatures Of Our God And King”
  - “Everyday”

## Gospel Assurance:

- Our need for Jesus
  - Make me to know your ways, O LORD; teach me your paths.  
**Lead me in your truth and teach me, for you are the God of my salvation; for you I wait all the day long.**  
Remember your mercy, O LORD, and your steadfast love, for they have been from of old.  
**Remember not the sins of my youth or my transgressions; according to your steadfast love remember me, for the sake of your goodness, O LORD!**  
(Psalm 25:4-7)
- God’s grace
  - *For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is his steadfast love toward those who fear him; as far as the east is from the west, so far does he remove our transgressions from us. As a father shows compassion to his*

*children, so the LORD shows compassion to those who fear him. (Psalm 103:11–13 ESV)*

- “His Mercy Is More”
- “How Deep The Father’s Love For Us”

What We Believe: As a church we want to affirm our unity in what we believe.

- *We believe that our Heavenly Father has highly exalted His Son, Jesus Christ, and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.*

*(Based on Philippians 2:9-11)*

Prayer: We bring our requests to the Lord through Jesus Christ.

Church Life/Greeting: In Christ, we live and fellowship together as believers. We take time to learn what is going on in our church, and to greet one another as we worship.

Prayer for Understanding: We pray that God will open our hearts and minds to the preaching of His Word.

Sermon:

- Matthew 28:16-20

Lord’s Supper: In taking communion together, we remember the death of Christ as we proclaim it to one another as we consume the elements.

- “My Life Is An Offering”

Praise to God (Doxology): We end our time of worship together as we resound in praises together.

- “Let Your Kingdom Come”

God Blesses: We go into the world this week with God’s blessings as He enables us to serve Him.

- *Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. (Romans 1:7 ESV)*
