

# Order of Worship

June 16, 2019

Preparing Our Hearts: If you arrive a little early, prepare your heart for worship by reading and thinking about this text:

- *Who is a God like you, pardoning iniquity and passing over transgression for the remnant of his inheritance? He does not retain his anger forever, because he delights in steadfast love.* (Micah 7:18 ESV)

Call to Worship:

- God calls us to worship
  - *Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, with thankfulness in your hearts to God. And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.* (Colossians 3:16–17 ESV)
- We humbly respond with praise
  - “You Stand Alone”
  - “The Lord Is”

Gospel Assurance:

- Our need for Jesus
  - *Show us your steadfast love, O LORD, and grant us your salvation. Let me hear what God the LORD will speak, for he will speak peace to his people, to his saints; but let them not turn back folly. Surely his salvation is near to those who fear him, that glory may dwell in our land.* (Psalm 85:7–9 ESV)
  - Prayer of Confession
- God’s grace
  - *Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. Through him we have also obtained access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and we rejoice in hope of the glory of God. Not only that, but we rejoice in our*

*sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, and endurance produces character, and character produces hope, and hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us.*  
(Romans 5:1–5 ESV)

- “Rejoice”

What We Believe: As a church we want to affirm our unity in what we believe.

- “We Believe”

Prayer: We bring our requests to the Lord through Jesus Christ.

Church Life/Greeting: In Christ, we live and fellowship together as believers. We take time to learn what is going on in our church, and to greet one another as we worship.

Prayer for Understanding: We pray that God will open our hearts and minds to the preaching of His Word.

Sermon:

- Judges 13:1

Lord's Supper: In taking communion together, we remember the death of Christ as we proclaim it to one another as we consume the elements.

- “I Will Glory In My Redeemer”

Praise to God (Doxology): We end our time of worship together as we resound in praises together.

- “How Can I Keep From Singing”

God Blesses: We go into the world this week with God's blessings as He enables us to serve Him.

- *May the God of peace be with you all. Amen.*
