Preparing Our Hearts: If you arrive a little early, prepare your heart for worship by reading and thinking about this text:

- *And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, “Behold, the dwelling place of God is with man. He will dwell with them, and they will be his people, and God himself will be with them as their God. (Revelation 21:3 ESV)*

Call to Worship:

- God calls us to worship
  - *God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble. Therefore we will not fear though the earth gives way, though the mountains be moved into the heart of the sea, though its waters roar and foam, though the mountains tremble at its swelling. (Psalm 46:1–3 ESV)*
- We humbly respond with praise
  - “Shout To The Lord”
  - “Holy, Holy, Holy”

Gospel Assurance:

- Our need for Jesus
  - *Be still, and know that I am God. I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth! The LORD of hosts is with us; the God of Jacob is our fortress. (Psalm 46:10–11 ESV)*
  - Prayer of Confession
- God’s grace
  - *Then the angel showed me the river of the water of life, bright as crystal, flowing from the throne of God and of the Lamb through the middle of the street of the city; also, on either side of the river, the tree of life with its twelve kinds of fruit, yielding its fruit each month. The leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations. No longer will there be anything accursed, but the throne of God and of the Lamb will be in it, and his servants will worship him. They will see his face, and his name*

*will be on their foreheads. And night will be no more. They will need no light of lamp or sun, for the Lord God will be their light, and they will reign forever and ever. (Revelation 22:1–5 ESV)*

- “Mighty To Save”
- “The Solid Rock”

What We Believe: As a church we want to affirm our unity in what we believe.

- *We believe that Christ is very man and very God; with respect to His human nature, He is no more on earth; but with respect to His Godhead, majesty, grace and spirit, He is at no time absent from us. Amen. (Heidelberg Catechism, Q. 47)*

Prayer: We bring our requests to the Lord through Jesus Christ.

Church Life/Greeting: In Christ, we live and fellowship together as believers. We take time to learn what is going on in our church, and to greet one another as we worship.

Prayer for Understanding: We pray that God will open our hearts and minds to the preaching of His Word.

Sermon:

- Matthew 28:16-20

Lord’s Supper: In taking communion together, we remember the death of Christ as we proclaim it to one another as we consume the elements.

- “Revelation Song”

Praise to God (Doxology): We end our time of worship together as we resound in praises together.

- “Shout To The North”

God Blesses: We go into the world this week with God’s blessings as He enables us to serve Him.

- *May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may abound in hope. (Romans 15:13 ESV)*
