
Order of Worship July 14, 2019

Preparing Our Hearts: If you arrive a little early, prepare your heart for worship by reading and thinking about this text:

- *As a father shows compassion to his children, so the Lord shows compassion to those who fear him. (Psalm 103:13)*

Call to Worship:

- God calls us to worship:
 - *Because your steadfast love is better than life, my lips will praise you. So I will bless you as long as I live; in your name I will lift up my hands. (Psalm 63:3-4)*
- We humbly respond with praise:
 - Congregational Song: "This Is My Father's World"
 - Congregational Song: "You, Oh Lord, Are a Great God"

Gospel Assurance:

- Our need for Jesus:
 - *A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another. By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another. (John 13:34-35)*
 - Prayer of confession.
- God's grace:
 - *In this the love of God was made manifest among us, that God sent his only Son into the world, so that we might live through him. In this is love, not that we have loved God but that he loved us and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins. Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another. (1 John 4:9-11)*
 - Congregational Song: "You Are My King (Amazing Love)"
 - Congregational Song: "'Tis so Sweet"

What We Believe: As a church we want to affirm our unity in what we believe.

- *We believe that all who trust in Jesus—who believe in his name—God has given the right to become his children. They have been born not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God. Amen. (Based on John 1:12-13)*

Prayer: We bring our requests to the Lord through Jesus Christ.

Church Life/Greeting: In Christ, we live and fellowship together as believers. We take time to learn what is going on in our church, and to greet one another as we worship.

Prayer for Understanding: We pray that God will open our hearts and minds to the preaching of His Word.

Sermon:

- Ephesians 6:1-4

Lord's Supper: In taking communion together, we remember the death of Christ as we proclaim it to one another as we consume the elements.

- Congregational Song: "Arise, My Soul, Arise"

Praise to God (Doxology): We end our time of worship together as we resound in praises together.

- Congregational Song: "Great Things"

God Blesses: We go into the world this week with God's blessings as He enables us to serve Him.

- *According to the foreknowledge of God the Father, in the sanctification of the Spirit, for obedience to Jesus Christ and for sprinkling with his blood: May grace and peace be multiplied to you. (1 Peter 1:2)*
