## Order of Worship October 6, 2019

Preparing Our Hearts: If you arrive a little early, prepare your heart for worship by reading and thinking about this text:

- *For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.* (Mark 10:45)

### Call to Worship:

- God calls us to worship:
  - *Praise the Lord! Praise, O servants of the Lord, praise the name of the Lord! Blessed be the name of the Lord from this time forth and forevermore! From the rising of the sun to its setting, the name of the Lord is to be praised!* (Psalm 113:1-3)
- We humbly respond with praise:
  - Congregational Song: “Praise to the Lord the Almighty”
  - Congregational Song: “Here I Am to Worship”

### Gospel Assurance:

- Our need for Jesus:
  - *And you were dead in the trespasses and sins in which you once walked, following the course of this world, following the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that is now at work in the sons of disobedience—among whom we all once lived in the passions of our flesh, carrying out the desires of the body and the mind, and were by nature children of wrath, like the rest of mankind.* (Ephesians 2:1-3)
  - Prayer of confession.
- God’s grace:
  - *But God, being rich in mercy, because of the great love with which he loved us, even when we were dead in our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ—by grace you have been saved—and raised us up with him and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, so that in the coming ages he might show the immeasurable riches of his grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.* (Ephesians 2:4-7)
  - Congregational Song: “Come Thou Fount”
  - Congregational Song: “You Are My King (Amazing Love)”

What We Believe: As a church we want to affirm our unity in what we believe.

- We believe sanctification is the work of God’s free grace, whereby we are renewed in the whole man after the image of God, and are enabled more and more to die unto sin, and live unto righteousness. (Westminster Shorter Catechism Q. 35)

Prayer: We bring our requests to the Lord through Jesus Christ.

Church Life/Greeting: In Christ, we live and fellowship together as believers. We take time to learn what is going on in our church, and to greet one another as we worship.

Prayer for Understanding: We pray that God will open our hearts and minds to the preaching of His Word.

Sermon:

- Philippians 1:1-2

Lord's Supper: In taking communion together, we remember the death of Christ as we proclaim it to one another as we consume the elements.

- Congregational Song: "In Christ Alone"

Praise to God (Doxology): We end our time of worship together as we resound in praises together.

- Congregational Song: "To God Be the Glory"

God Blesses: We go into the world this week with God's blessings as He enables us to serve Him.

- *The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit.* (Philippians 4:23)
